Students learn and grow best when the adults in their community work together to support them.

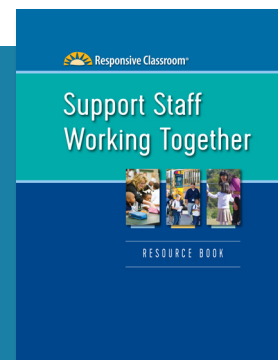
